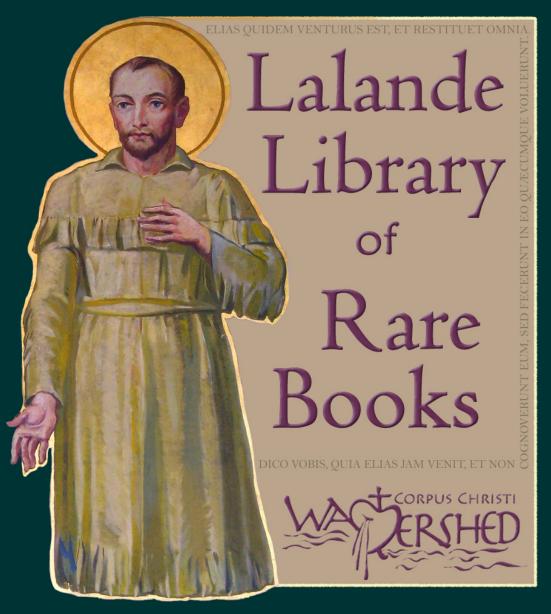

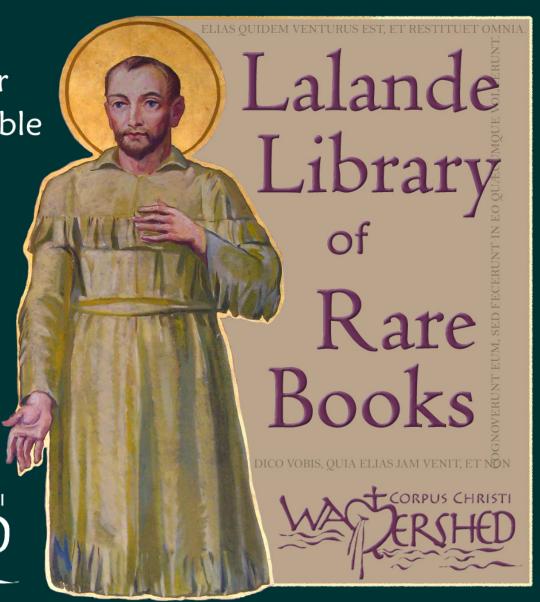

I. As **Note-signs**, the square note (punctum) \blacksquare , the tailed-note (virga) \blacksquare or \blacksquare , the lozenge or diamond (rhombus) \blacklozenge , and the quilisma \blacksquare .


The time-value of these notes is *not* different. In particular, the tailed-note \P does not indicate a *longer* tone than \blacksquare or \blacklozenge , but only a *higher* tone.

II. As Neums, a) Full neums, as hitherto used in the Editio Medicæa, e. g., Full neums, as hitherto used in the


b) Liquescent neums in which the second and sometimes also the third note have a note of a modified form opposite the first note, e. g., h. These neums are used at the transition of one syllable to another when two or three consonants occur together (sanctus); also at au (laudamus) and j (alleluja). The mode of rendering is, however, the same as for full neums.

As regards the *rendering*, the neums are divided into those a) With **one** accent, to which belong:

1. Clivis (a) and Cephálicus (β):



2. Podátus (α) and Epíphonus (β):



Always sing the *lower note first* and take particular care, especially with the wider intervals, not to accentuate or prolong the upper note.

3. Bistropha $\blacksquare \blacksquare = \prod$ (to be sung p).

4. Tórculus and its liquescent secondary form:




Do not treat this neum as a triplet, especially if a neum with two notes precedes it.

5. Porréctus:



With regard to the thick oblique stroke, which does not indicate a louder tone, only the extreme ends of the stroke show the notes to be sung.

- 7. Climacus:









Neums with three accents are rare.

By means of these accents the plain chant melodies receive their **rhythmical divisions.** Moreover, of importance for the rhythm is the pressus, as it is called, which occurs when of two neums meeting together on one syllable one ends on the same tone as that with which the other begins. In this case the *first* of the two notes of the same pitch is sung with a *sforzato*:




If the first of the neums forming the pressus consists of only two notes, the first note loses the accent, therefore



A flat (5) holds good only for the note concerned; therefore in the 2nd Kyrie Summe Deus, p. 71*, si (not sa) must be sung after the pause.

The **pauses** are indicated by vertical lines; their duration is determined according as they are drawn through the top, the two middle lines, or all four lines. An asterisk * in the text shows how far the cantor has to intone. The last note before a pause must never be cut off abruptly; if a neum with two notes occurs before a pause, the duration of both notes is usually doubled, e. g., Kyriale, p. 25*:
